The University of Warwick (The University) Estates Office recognises that our activities impact upon the environment through our routine internal operations, our infrastructural development and our influence on the wider community. We have committed to operate a formal Environmental Management System (EMS) to the requirements of the International Standard ISO 14001:2015.

It is our policy to:

- Fulfill all compliance obligations including relevant laws, regulations and voluntary obligations (to which The University subscribes) relating to our environmental aspects
- To identify and assess the significant environmental aspects and impacts of our activities and implement appropriate measures to reduce their potential environmental impact including a commitment to:
 - Protect the environment
 - Embed sustainable design principles in our projects
 - Continual improvement of our environmental management system
- Set and review environmental objectives and targets in order to measure our environmental performance.
- Provide employee training to enhance environmental awareness of the potential impacts from operations and the use of suitable control measures and that persons performing tasks on our behalf are competent to undertake them
- The Environmental Management Group is responsible for implementing this policy and monitoring our environmental performance.
