Income from non-UK domiciled (international) students generates **indirect and induced impacts** throughout the UK economy.

The impact of UK-domiciled students is captured separately under "Impact of Teaching and Learning".

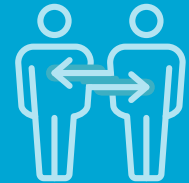

The total economic impact associated with the University's **educational exports** in 2019-20 was estimated to be **£1,048m (£675m of that in the West Midlands region)**.
