Roles & Responsibilities:

- Run volunteering sessions, which includes collecting resources, setting up the crafts, activities, refreshments, briefing, supervising, and supporting volunteers, clearing up and packing away resources.
- Support Project Leaders to maintain regular communication with volunteers e.g. sending session information, reminder and thank you emails to volunteers.
- Support Project Leaders to manage social media accounts and create content.
- Maintain regular communication with Project Leaders to provide feedback and inform them of any issues.
- Read and review the project risk assessment and volunteer brief.
- Update records of activities and volunteer attendance as required.
- Work with Project Leaders to prepare handover resources for new Student Leaders.
- Actively uphold Warwick Volunteers policies and procedures.

All Student Leaders will receive ongoing support and guidance from Warwick Volunteers and will work alongside a designated staff member.
