Warwickshire Wildlife Trust

Working in Tocil Wood, the bluebell wood on the University of Warwick campus, which enjoys protected status as a Site of Special Scientific Interest.

Volunteer days are usually held on Wednesdays and Saturdays. There is flexibility to hold sessions on different days and times.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Promote the project and actively recruit volunteers. Including updating the project webpage and creating publicity resources as required.
- Liaise with Friends of Canley Green Spaces and Warwickshire Wildlife Trust to arrange regular sessions throughout the year.
- Update volunteers with all the relevant information prior to the volunteer activity.
- Manage a project budget.
- Recruit and train a small team of Session Leaders to help support volunteer activities.
- Organise resources for each session.
- Create a spreadsheet to record activities and volunteer attendance.
- Review and update the project risk assessment and volunteer brief with support from Warwick Volunteers staff.
- Maintain regular communication with the Warwick Volunteers staff team to keep them up to date with progress and inform them of any issues.
- Gain feedback and quotes from volunteers and community partners.
- Prepare a handover for the new Project Leaders.
- Actively uphold Warwick Volunteers policies and procedures.
- Applicants must be available to volunteer 3 Saturdays a term and available to volunteer during the week too (days and times flexible).

All Project Leaders will receive ongoing support and guidance from Warwick Volunteers and will work alongside a designated staff member.
