Prior to session

- Sign up to the sessions you would like to lead
- Read through Volunteer Briefing, Project Confirmation and risk assessment
- Check the online sign up
- Advertise and promote the project (Instagram and WV Newsletter)

On the day

- Print out the register
- Take key information (Volunteer Briefing, Project Confirmation and risk assessment and register)
- Meet volunteers you can meet the volunteers wearing a WV hoodie
- Ask volunteers to sign the register and save to shared folder after the session
- Read key points in Volunteer Briefing (schedule, key health and safety info)
- Depending on size of the group you could get volunteers to introduce themselves
- Introduce yourself and the community partner and find out what the tasks are for the day
- Take photos of volunteers (check volunteers are happy for their photo to be taken and put on social media)
- Supervise volunteers with support of community partners.
- Ensure activity keeps to schedule and volunteers are back on campus on time
- After the activity giving feedback about the session to your Project Leaders
- Uploading a list of active volunteers and emailing volunteers to thank them.

What will you gain

- Leadership skills
- Event management

Time commitment

Session leaders are expected to help lead around 4-5 sessions per term. Sessions are typically held during the week and run for a morning or afternoon.

All Session Leaders will receive ongoing support and guidance from Warwick Volunteers and will work alongside designated Project Leaders.
