### **Intended use and audience - coin supply in the Roman provinces of Pannonia, Dacia, and Moesia.**

The problem of establishing a coin circulation and distribution pattern with regards to military in the Roman Empire is challenging. This presentation is concerned with coin circulation and distribution patterns in military contexts in the provinces of the Middle and Lower Danube, e.g. Pannonia, Dacia, and Moesia. Regional coin circulation and distribution patterns are investigated and specific coin denominations and types predominantly linked to military context are explored. Furthermore, case studies are presented to understand the roles of local coinages in coin supply to military in the 3rd-century AD. In conclusion, the results from the proposed study raise significant questions with regards to the present approaches.
