A comprehensive grasp of the issues discussed on the module, and the ability to construct a nuanced and persuasive argument.

Effectively structured and referenced and communicated in a lucid and engaging register throughout.

74-78 Low/Lower-Mid First

An excellent research essay in all respects. Work demonstrates a very good grasp of the critical issues relevant to the course topics, very strong engagement with relevant and well-chosen wider critical materials.

A perceptive analysis that goes some way to an original essay, and the ability to construct a convincing argument.

Effectively structured and referenced and clearly expressed in an appropriate register throughout.

62-68 Upper Second

A very good research essay. Work displays sound knowledge of the relevant course topics and the issues they raise more widely, strong engagement with wider critical materials

Offers some convincing analysis and some attempt at the construction of an argument. Goes some way towards the originality and/or insight of a first-class answer.

Generally articulate and well-structured using appropriate referencing and clarity of expression.

52-58 Lower Second

A good or adequate research essay. Responses exhibit sufficient knowledge of course topics and/or surrounding issues. Some engagement with wider critical materials, although not necessarily as relevant.

There may be some evidence of the construction of an argument.

There are some problems with clarity of expression and referencing.

42-48 Third

A basic, pass-level research essay. A limited response to the tasks set which, whilst exhibiting limited knowledge of course topics and/or surrounding issues, lacks substance and engagement with wider critical materials.

Significant errors in clarity of expression and omissions in referencing.

12 - 38 Fail

A poor essay but with some redeeming evidence of effort and/or engagement with course topics and/or surrounding issues/critical materials.

There may be serious errors and omissions and it is likely also to be poorly written and/or poorly organised.
