

EN3K7 The Novel Now: Reading the Novel in the 21st Century
Finalists' presentation

As a finalist you are required to do a presentation on a topic of your choice, drawing on one or two of the novels in the syllabus, to be held during one of the seminars. A schedule will be posted on TEAMS so that you can choose a date and topic – preferably coinciding with the date in which the novel you will discuss will be the focus of the seminar. All topics must be pre-approved by the convenor. Please keep in mind the following:

- each presentation should take a minimum of ten minutes and a maximum of fifteen so that there is time, up to ten minutes for questions to be posed and answered.
- each presentation will be assessed and counts for 20% of the overall mark for the module.
- Each presentation must include a set of Power-point slides and/or handout. These should be sent to the convenor ahead of the date for the presentation so they can be posted on TEAMS or if the seminar will be held online they must be posted on the chat function of TEAMS and the student presenting should show the presentation or handout by sharing their screen with the seminar. Please keep these brief (a maximum of six slides and/or two A4 pages).
- Each handout/slide presentation must have a clear outline as well as a short bibliography.
- Presentations can be used as preparation for the final essay for the module.
- If for some reason you are not able to present on the scheduled date, please email convenor for an alternate date. If this would fall outside of T2 a 1000-word brief essay may be substituted – but then this cannot be used at all for the final essay.
