






1. Latin American Countries in the 19th Century.




- Big territories, little population
- Relative homogeneity (cultural)
- Mostly rural. Little urbanization
- Low literacy rates
- “Free” from external control



Stability? Prosperity?

- Low economic growth
- Sources of wealth destroyed
- Constant civil unrest
- Civil wars
- Border disputes
- Invasions






