Iran: It is two weeks since the arrival of the W.F.T.U.'s Delegation to Iran. It is too early yet to surmise the views of the delegates and the results of their visit. Reports from Tehran say that they are visiting various establishments, and enjoy the hospitality of Iranian authorities. Nevertheless reports by certain papers that reactionary elements continue their activities against the Central United Council and that at the back of the Delegation they try to repress and persecute workers draw attention. Recently Aras Mardom and Fereshteh Azadi have frequently written that officials appointed by the authorities to guide the W.F.T.U.'s delegates are impeding their contact with the members of the Central United Council and workers. Thus they refused entrance to the members of the Central United Council into Hotel Darband. According to Mardum on March 4 when the Federation's delegates visited the Tobacco Factory the Government Syndicates, formed a circle round them, and did not let them get into contact with workers' representatives. In that factory too, as in the case of the cement factory, they speedily managed to send away workers, who are in favour of the Central United Council, from the premises. According to press reports the active members of the Union are put under arrest and persecuted.

The official representatives of Iranian authorities are not sparing in words expressing thankfulness and gratitude to the W.F.T.U., and their confidence in the Federation which has sent delegates to Iran. Several receptions were given in Tehran to their honour. However, nevertheless, this official hospitality to be reconciled with measures calculated to check the fulfilment of the Mission which those delegates of the W.F.T.U. have come to Iran for?
