SES POSIBLE EL RETORNO DE LOS CHILENOS

PREAMBULO

Esta es una edición revisada y actualizada en Español de un artículo publicado por Academics for Chile en Septiembre de 1979 con el título 'Is the neturn of Chilean exiles possible?' Aun cuando la mayor parte de tal artículo sigue vigente se ha considerado necesario publicar un documento en Español al cual tenga acceso toda la comunidad chilena en el exterior y sectores interesados al interior del país.

La experiencia acumulada en un año en torno al problema del retorno lamentablemente confirma la tesis planteada en el artículo de 1979. Allí se sostiene que aun cuando la insensa mayoría de los chilenos exiliados puede teóricamente volver al país sin trabas legales, en la práctica el retorno masivo se hace dificultoso por las condiciones impuestas por la ditadura en el país y por la arbitrariedad que caracteriza sus decisiones.


Este artículo, a diferencia de su versión en ingles, no pondrá el acento en el análisis de los decretos leyes, aun cuando por supuesto se hace referencia a ellos, sino en lo que ha sido la experiencia concreta derivada de la legislación impuesta por la dictadura. Afortundamente, ahora existe cierta información disponible aunque no es la deseable para un análisis completo del problema. Todavía persisten serias limitaciones en la disponibilidad de antecedentes estadísticos.

chilenos empezaron a orientar a su militancia acerca de la importancia del retorno al país como aspecto fundamental de la lucha contra la dictadura. Este problema tambien ha empezado a preocupar a diversas instituciones que directa o indirectamente están vinculados a la campaña de solidaridad con el pueblo de Chile y por el respeto a los derechos humanos. Es más, el retorno se ha transformado en un tópico de creciente discusión al interior de Chile y es motivo de constante preocupación no sólo en los organismos de oposición legal e ilegal sino en el seno de la propia dictadura y sus organismos de apoyo. En un extenso artículo aparecido en 'El Mercur en Enero del presente año se califica a la campaña por el retorno como elemento importantísimo en la lucha interna y externa contra la dictadura. Un mes después el Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores envió una circular secreta a las embajadas y consulado de Chile impartiendo instrucciones precisas acerca del retorno de exiliados. Por otra parte, en el mes de Junio se realizaron en Santiago las Primeras Jornadas por el Derecho a Vivir en la Patria convocada por la Comisión Chilena de Derechos Humanos y el Comité Pro Retorno de Exiliados.

Sin embargo, es necesario decir que la Campaña por el Retorno a Chile se está promoviendo y discutiendo en un contexto que debe ser cabalmente comprendido, particularmente por aquellos chilenos que pueden y desean regresar en un futuro próximo. En primer lugar, la Campaña se está promoviendo en circunstancias que no han ocurrido cambios significativos en el país que garanticen el retorno masivo de los exiliados. El retorno se ha iniciado sin que, al menos substancial mente, hubieran cambiado las condiciones que obliga-
