INFINITIVES

The infinitive is the form of the verb that you can find in the dictionary. The verb denotes an action or a state of being. The Spanish infinitives end in <u>ar</u>, **er** and **ir**:

hablar (to speak), comer (to eat), vivir (to live).

Amar y **saber**, no puede todo **ser**. (*Love and prudence cannot go together*)

Querer es **poder**. (Where there is a will, there is a way)

Vivir para **ver**. (*Live and learn*)

Más vale **morir** de pie que **vivir** arrodillado. (*It's better to die on your feet than to live on your knees*)
