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Do you know any Japanese words?

Only 5 vowels

a (banana), i (igloo), u(push), e (egg), o (orange)



Just be careful with long vs short vowels.

e.g. Obasan (aunt) vs obaasan (grandmother)

3 character sets

- **Hiragana (sound)**
- **Katakana (sound) for foreign words**
- Kanji <Chinese characters> (sound & meaning)
