

No word order change in question. Just add "ka"

Is this ? (Question)

This isn't



dewa arimasen

e.g. Kore wa hon desu ka?

"hon" needs to be repeated.

iie, (kore wa) hon dewa arimasen.

"Kore wa" in the reply is often omitted as the topic has been already established.

Kore (this)

Japan-language in

これは にほんごで なん ですか。

Kaban desu.

かばん です。

What is it in  
Japanese?

(It is) a bag.

Furansu-go (French), chuugoku-go(Chinese), **ei-go** (English)



## 9 Practice

Is this Miss Sato's umbrella?

Hai, Sato-san no kasa desu .

Yes, it is Sato's umbrella.

Iie, Sato-san no kasa dewa arimasen.  
Hayashi-san no kasa desu.

No, it is not Miss Sato's  
umbrella. It is Miss Hayashi's.

Kasa (umbrella), bo^shi (hat), kaban (bag),  
Kagi(key) keitai(mobile) tokei (watch) megane (glasses)

Note:

1) Kasa ja arimasen = kasa dewa arimasen

2) “Hayashi-san no kasa desu” can be shortened to “Hayashi-san no desu.”  
(It is Ms. Hayashi's umbrella) (It is Ms. Hayashi's.)



# 10. Whose.....

"watashi", "sensei" "Tanaka-san"

Kore wa  no  desu

This is 's 

Kore wa  ? no  desu ka  
dare

Whose  is  
this?

"dare" means "who".

e.g. Kore wa dare no keitai desu ka. Whose mobile is this?

- watashi no (keitai) desu. It is mine.

- Ken san no (keitai) desu. It is Ken's.

"keitai" can be omitted

Note: kore wa **donata no** keitai desu ka? (more polite)

dare (who) donata (who <polite>)



# 11. The telephone number is...

denwa bangou wa 123 - 4567 desu

*The telephone number is 123-4567*

Read as "no"

denwa bangou wa nanban desu ka

*What (number) is the telephone number?*

*Practice: Ask and tell your number.*

Denwa (phone), bangou (number), nan ban (what number)
