5. 'Doing Something to See How It Goes'

To express the idea of 'do something and see how it goes' or 'try and ...', you use **Te form** followed by $\mathcal{A} \sharp \uparrow$.

I will wear this coat. (わたしは) このコートを きます。

I will try on (wear) this coat.
(to see how it suite/fit on me).
