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To express the idea of indefinite place, things ,or people, you put *\daggerafter the question words.

Question words どこか Where

I will go <u>to university.</u>

somewhere

Mr Honda is in the room. someone

I will buy <u>a book</u>. something

I will go to Japan <u>next year.</u> sometime

<u>somewhere</u> どこか

Will you go somewhere?

どこかいきますか。

Would you like to go somewhere? どこか いきませんか。

I want to go somewhere.

どこか いきたいです。

on weekend As it will be holiday next week. tomorrow

Will you go somewhere next Tuesday?

I want to go <u>somewhere</u> next year.

As it is a good weather today, would you like to go <u>somewhere</u>?

<u>nowhere</u> どこも

I will go nowhere.

どこもいきません。

<u>something</u> なにか

I will buy souvenirs.

おみやげをかいます。

...but not sure what to buy.

I will buy some souvenirs.

<u>なにか</u> おみやげ を かいます。

I will buy some food.

<u>なにか</u> たべもの を かいます。

I will eat some fruits.

なにか くだもの を たべます。

I will drink some hot drink.

なにか あつい のみもの を のみます。
