2. Asking for and Offering Explanations (1)

You use h c d to ask about another person's circumstances, and $h \circ f$ to make someone else better understand your own.

Asking for explanations

Feel surprise, suspicious, interesting, worried...

Where are you going to go to? どこに 行きますか。 Why are you going to go out? だくんですか

Emphasize

Giving explanations

I am going to go to buy some cigarettes.
