5. Not yet

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The Te form followed by sometimes includes that something has not yet occurred or has not yet been achieved.

Q. : Have you already finished you report?

もう、レポートを 書きましたか。

A. : Yes, I have already.

もう、書きました。

No, I haven't yet. (I mean to do so, but.....)

いいえ、**まだ** 書いていません。

No, I did not write it. (I don't have an intension to do so)

いいえ、書きませんでした。
