THE NEW WOMEN'S MOVEMENT IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC

Legislation:

- Grundgesetz decrees male-female equality to be binding in all aspects of the law 1949 Article 3, Paragraph 2: "Männer und Frauen sind gleichberechtigt."
- Frauenlohngruppen (special wage-rate groups for female labour) made illegal by the Federal Labour Court
- Gleichberechtigungsgesetz passed by the Bundestag 1957
- Bundestag passes law allowing abortion up to the third month of pregnancy, the 1974 so-called Fristenlösung (time-limited abortion)
- this legislation declared unconstitutional by the Bundesverfassungsgericht (Federal 1975 Constitutional Court)
- new legislation passed by parliament making a legal abortion possible on medical, 1976 eugenic, criminological, or social grounds
- following a legal amendment adopting the former GDR abortion law (June 1992) 1993 for the whole of Germany, the Fristenlösung is again declared unconstitutional but not a punishable offence

Statistics:

- first German women's film festival and workshop in Berlin 1973
- Frauen und Film, a feminist film journal, founded by Helke Sander 1974
- publication of Alice Schwarzer's Der 'kleine Unterschied' und die großen Folgen 1975 founding of Frauenoffensive publishing house publication of Verena Stefan's Häutungen
- first shelter for battered women founded in West Berlin 1976 founding of Courage (September)
- founding of Emma (January) 1977
- formation of Association of Women Film-Makers 1979
