- fill-in-the gaps
- Choose the correct verb form / Choose the correct grammar form
- Write the tense (e.g. future, imperative, etc) of the following verbs (verb conjugation)
- Re-write the sentences using the right form of...
- Use the right form of...

Students are strongly encouraged to revise the following grammar topics – please check relevant chapters in *Italian Grammar in Practice* (syllabus) and lecture notes for further details on each topic:

- Imperfetto (conjugation and uses)
- Passato prossimo (conjugation and uses)
- Auxiliaries (Essere vs. Avere) and agreements with past participles
- Regular and irregular past participles
- *Volere, potere, dovere* (passato prossimo)

- Direct Object Pronouns
- Indirect Object Pronouns
- Reflexive Pronouns
- The particle *ne*
- The particle *ci*
- Combined pronouns and double object pronouns
- Position of pronouns
- Agreements/Positions of pronouns with past participles

- Future Simple (regular and irregular forms)
- Future Simple (uses)

- Informal imperative: affirmative/negative; regular/irregular forms; uses; position of pronouns with informal imperative
- Formal imperative: affirmative/negative; uses; position of pronouns with formal imperative– *you won't be asked to conjugate the formal imperative*
