- Supporting with logistics during the day (registration, movement, catering, acting as a point of contact between pupils, staff and the event organiser)
- Working with small groups of pupils on allocated language tasks
- Speaking to school pupils about the university experience and your own experience of learning languages
- Conducting campus tours
