What is a Recent Graduate Erasmus Traineeship?

It is Erasmus+ funding that you can receive when undertaking a 2–12-month, international work placement in Europe. This scheme is due to end in May 2023. The internship must take place within 1 year of the end date of your course and must start before March 2023.



What can I do?

You may carry out a traineeship at any organisation in an Erasmus+ Programme Country (except for EU institutions, bodies and agencies). This excludes the UK, Switzerland, Monaco and similar small principalities, but includes Turkey.

When do I apply for funding?

We need confirmation that your internship can be a Recent Graduate Erasmus Traineeship while you are still enrolled as a student at Warwick
