Magnus (-a, um; comp. – maior (m/f), maius (n); sup. – maximus (-a, um))

Omnis (-e; no comparison)

Orientalis (-e; no comparison)

Sacer (-a, um; comp. not attested; sup. – sacerrimus)

Solus (-a, -um; no comparison)

Activus (-a, um; comp. – activior; sup. – activissimus, -a, um)

Otiosus (-a, um; comp. – otiosior; sup. – otiosissimus, -a, um)

Contemplativus (-a, um; comp. – contemplativior; sup. – contemplativissimus, -a, um)

#### Task 2:

- 1) Fuit vir in oriente (in + Abl.) nomine (Abl. – “by the name”) Nemo
- 2) Magnus inter omnes (inter + Acc.) orientales (Acc.)
- 3) Per sacram scripturam (per + Acc.)
- 4) Solus [...] fuit iste sanctus compassus (double Nom., from esse) Lazaro (Dat., indir.obj.)
- 5) Ad aratrum (ad + Acc.) mittendo
- 6) Otiosos ad laborem (double Acc.) conducendo
