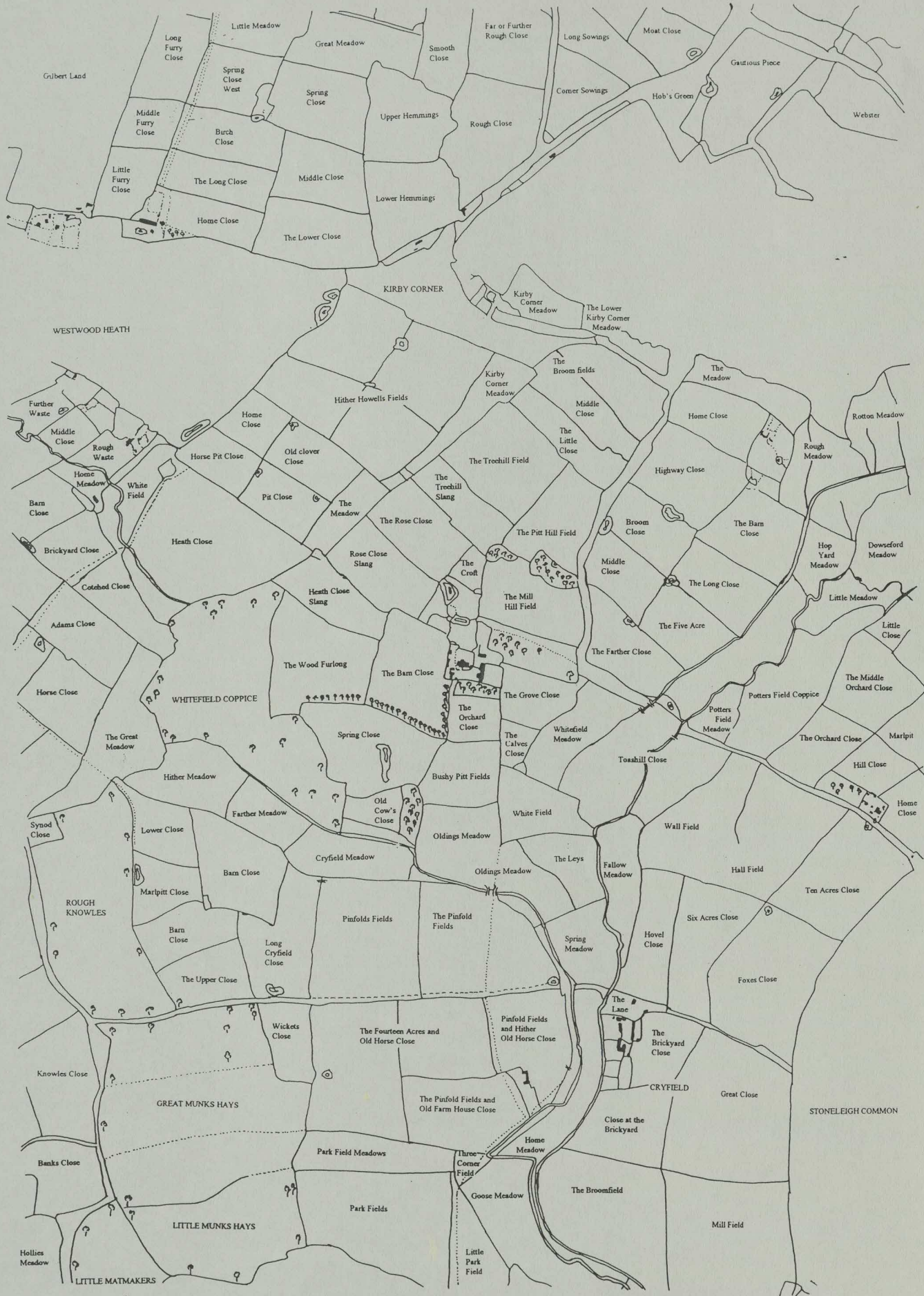

Dear Stephen,



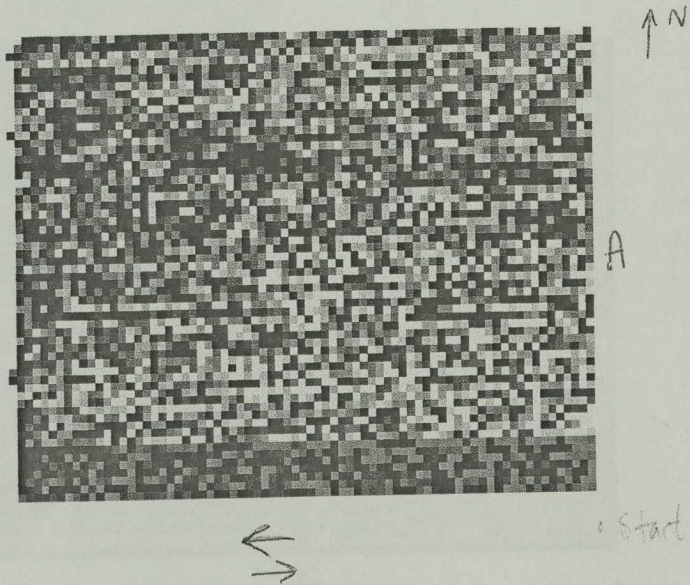

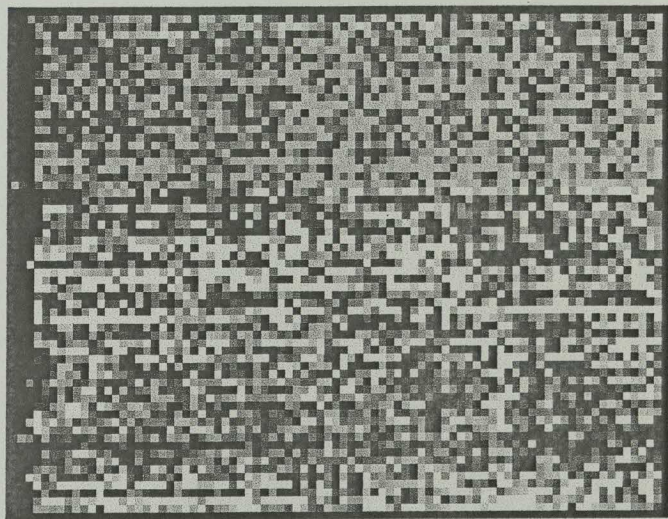

WESTWOOD EAST PITCH: (B) → See plan

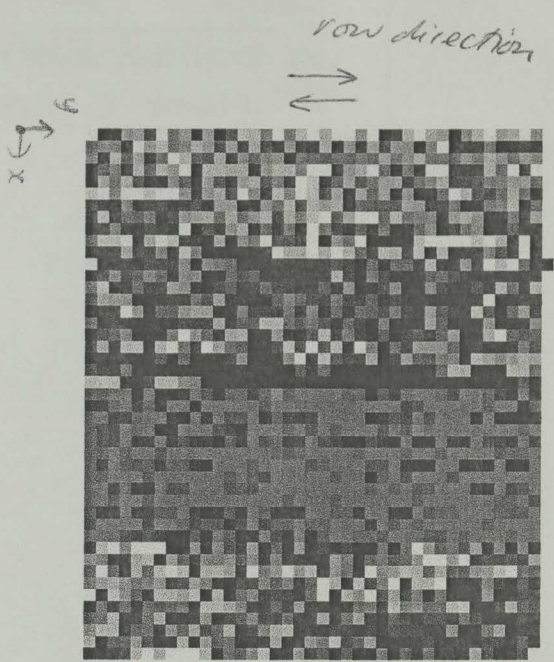
