# Our journey so far: Institute for Development & Diplomacy (IDD), ADA University



ADA University (formerly Azerbaijan Diplomatic Academy) was established in January 2014. It has grown to host 7 Schools, with nearly 4000 students, and 2500 alumni from 48 countries.



The <u>Institute for Development and Diplomacy</u> (IDD) was launched in 2022 to deepen engagement and impact on all-level communities of practice. IDD is a hub for policy-focused, interdisciplinary research and policy outputs, as well as a focal point for higher-level conferences, and roundtables.

IDD set up learning and research programmes with a focus on:

- Return to Karabakh: survey and development
