The Stegosaurus lived during the late Jurassic Period (150.8 million to 155.7 million years ago).

Stegosaurus means "roofed lizard."

The Stegosaurus lived mostly in western North America.



They were almost the size of a bus!!!!



The Stegosaurus had a very small brain.

They were plant eaters (herbivores).

# Triceratops

Did You Know?

Triceratops means "three-horned face" in Greek.



They had hard, parrot-like beaks.

The Triceratops' head is one of the largest of any land animal discovered.



Triceratops was a plant eater (herbivore).

Fully grown Triceratops were about 26ft in length (about 3.5 Christmas trees).

# Brachiosaurus

Did You Know?



Brachiosaurus was likely a warm-blooded animal.

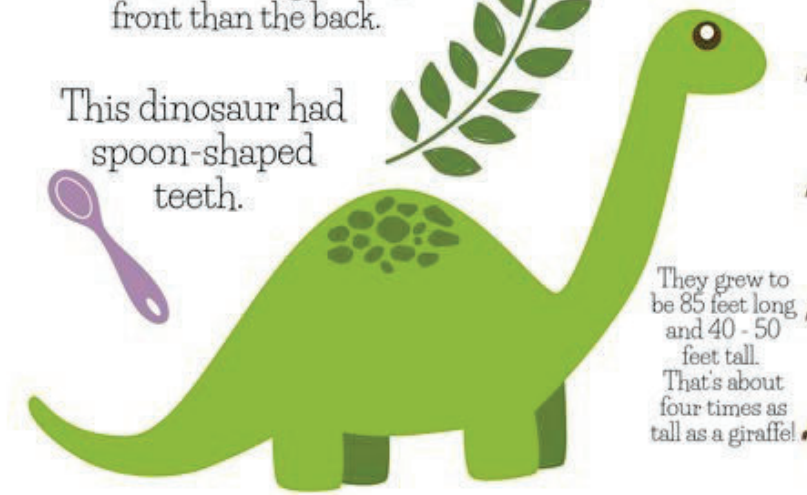
The name Brachiosaurus comes from Greek words meaning 'arm' and 'lizard'. The name refers to their legs which were longer at the front than the back.

Brachiosaurus was a plant eater (herbivore).

This dinosaur had spoon-shaped teeth.



They grew to be 85 feet long and 40 - 50 feet tall. That's about four times as tall as a giraffe!

# Parasaurolophus

## Did You Know?

Parasaurolophus was a plant eater (herbivore).



They had large head crests they used for trumpeting.

The length of Parasaurolophus is around 33 feet long, about 3 large Bengal tigers.



Some scientists theorize the crest on their heads were to help regulate their body temperature.



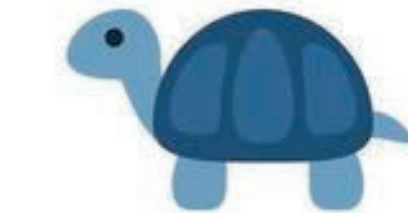

## Did You Know?

Pterosaurs were reptiles, (like turtles).



Some Pterosaurs were small enough to fit in the palm of your hand, while others had 30-foot wingspans.

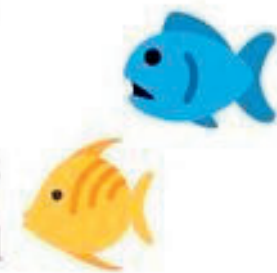


"Pteradactyl"

There isn't an actual dinosaur named "Pteradactyl." "Pteradactyl" is commonly used for Pterosaurs, Pterodactylus and Pteranodon in particular.

Pteranodon and Pterodactylus walked on four legs.

Pterosaurs were scavengers.



Pterodactylus probably had a diet that consisted of fish and other small animals.

Pterosaurs lived in the late Jurassic Period (about 150.8-148.5 million years ago).

Pterodactylus means "winged finger."

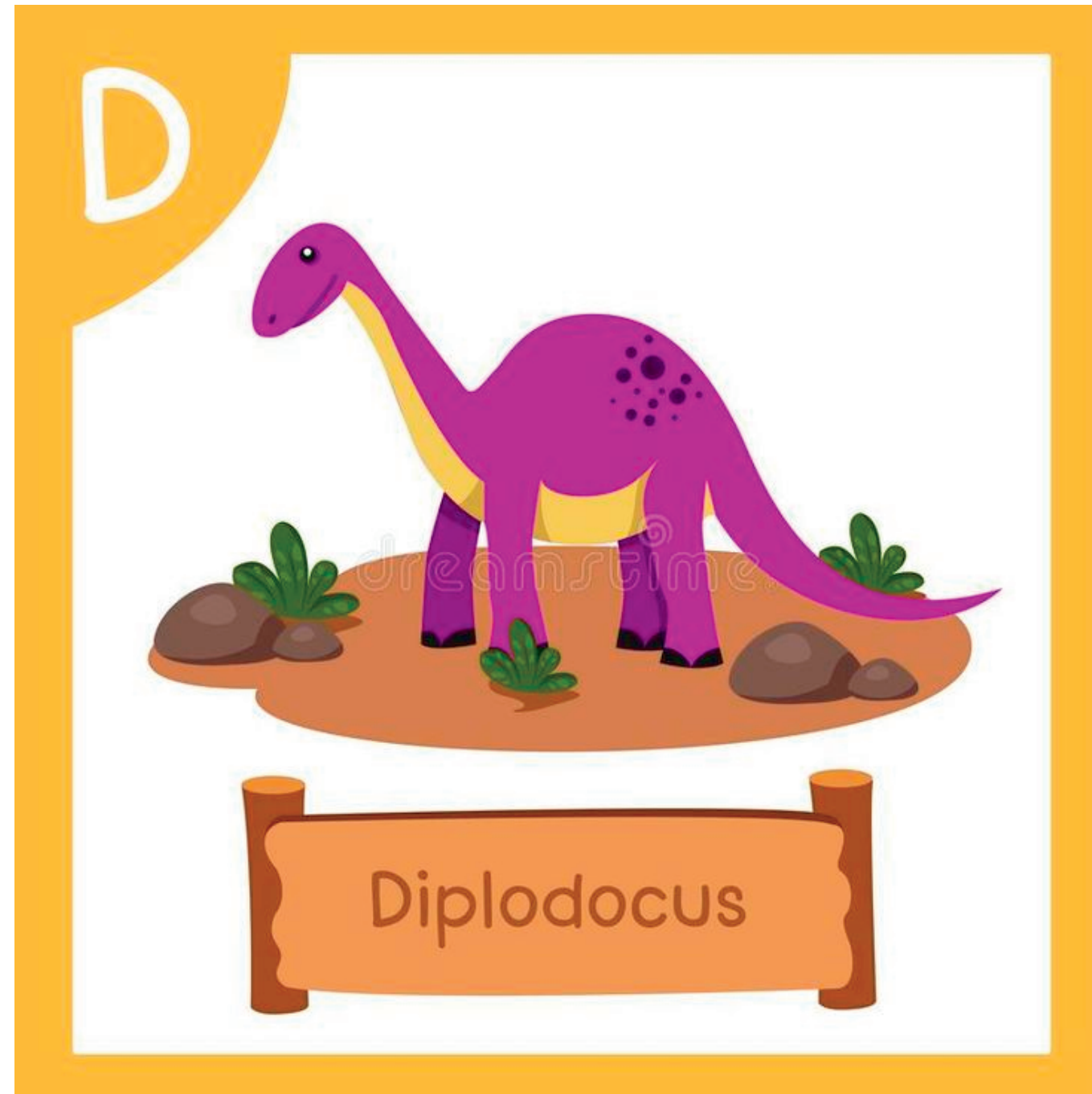

Means "**Double beamed lizard**"

Diplodocus had small, peg-like teeth at the front of its mouth, which means they could only swallow not chew!



Herbivore

Had a tiny head, long neck for grazing and a long whip-like tail

They lived about 154 to 150 million years ago - in the late Jurassic period.

Front legs were shorter than its back legs
