Project Rationale

- Internationalisation is central to Warwick's International Strategy 2024-2030, with almost 40% of students and staff being international, yet there was no central record of related activities.
- The 2024/25 pilot built a form and searchable database to capture these activities, but a short timeline limited sharing mainly to the WIHEA community, leaving scope to expand.

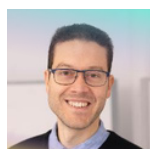
Current Progress and Reflections

- Sujaya Shrestha has taken a more systematic approach this year, reaching out to leading experts on internationalisation and colleagues across departments and centres to gather additional resources.
- The Internationalisation at Warwick resource page was officially launched at the Warwick Education Conference, bringing together internationalisation activities and projects from across the university in a searchable format.
- The launch generated strong support from participants, and the team is now focused on promoting the page more widely across the university.

Next Steps

- Advertise the resource page's launch to students and staff to maximise its impact and reach.
- Continue gathering and adding resources to the webpage through 2026/27.
