According to Jean Adler, Assistant Editor of the New Central European Observer, Boris TEMKOV, the Bulgarian Press Attache in London is the only member of the satellite officials in this country, who contributes articles to the New Central European Observer. He is regarded as being in very close touch with the Cominform, and as such is looked upon as the spiritual Communist leader of the satellite embassies in London.

A Certain CAMPBELL, said to be an important employee of the National Coal Board, who is a member of the British Communist Party, contributes to the New Central European Observer.

Another contributor is Desmond BUCKLE, a Gold Coast correspondent who is also correspondent of several Czech newspapers in Prague.
