In the context of the **i-Mean 5 Conference in Bristol, UK (6-8 April 2017)**, the 'Identity and Workplace Communication' MITN cluster is organising a panel which aims to bring together professional communication scholars to reflect on: 'Practising multidisciplinary in workplace studies'.

The abstract for the panel is the following:

Exploring multidisciplinary in workplace studies

The global workplace is fluid and transient and the need for a multidisciplinary enquiry in order to capture its complexity is widely acknowledged. However, the ways in which multidisciplinary can be implemented in practice are rarely explicitly discussed. This panel aims to bring together studies addressing professional communication from different angles to problematise the crossing of disciplinary boundaries, affordances and possible challenges. We focus on (socio)linguistic research and analysis and consider how our work can benefit from multidisciplinary without ending in 'a jack of all trades' position and losing the strengths of in-depth linguistic theoretical tools and analysis.

We specifically aim to address the following questions:

What do we understand as multidisciplinary?

What disciplines do workplace scholars typically draw upon?

How open is the academy to new approaches and methods?

Is multidisciplinary possible?

The panel consists of 6 papers addressing the topic followed by a roundtable discussion.


