Model Specification

Attributes of a Good Econometric Model

▶ Theoretical Consistency

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- ▶ **Parsimony** – Explain a lot with a little

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- ▶ **Identifiability** – For a set of data, unique values exist for the parameters
- ▶ **Predictive Power** – *Outside* the sample, the model is based on quantities observed *prior* to the time the prediction is needed
