On a grant:

All grant applications which rely on using the TM1 equipment must reference AWM as the funder as follows:

This application is supported by the facilities funded through Birmingham Science City: Clinical Research Infrastructure and Trials Platform (Translational Medicine Project 1), an AWM funded project which forms part of the Science City University of Warwick and University of Birmingham research alliance.

This can go in the "Main Case for Support" or in the "Justification for Resources". This includes all Research Council, European and national government grants. If you are applying for a charity/industrial grant and you have problems with this statement with the format of the application please let me know, I can arrange for an alternative.

On a paper:

All publications which report results obtained using Science City equipment need to carry the following acknowledgement:

"The [equipment name] used in this research was obtained, through Birmingham Science City Translational Medicine Clinical Research Infrastructure and Trials Platform, with support from Advantage West Midlands (AWM)".

Job Advert:

All job adverts created as a result of the Agency's investment must contain information about Birmingham Science City as follows:

"The successful candidate will be working [at name of the building/lab/ with equipment xxx] which is funded by Advantage West Midlands through Birmingham Science City Translational Medicine, Clinical Research Infrastructure and Trials Platform".

At a presentation/lecture:

If you present a poster or a PowerPoint which includes results obtained using Science City equipment you need to include the following words and logos:
