Nick Trahearn is a Postdoctoral Training Fellow at the Institute of Cancer Research, London. In his 9 years working in the field of Digital Pathology he has worked directly on projects for assistive diagnostics and for exploratory study of the tumour microenvironment. Originating from a computer science background, he began working on diagnostic whole slide images in 2013 when he joined the Tissue Image Analytics Lab at the University of Warwick, where he received his PhD in registration and multi-IHC analysis. His current research interests are in the use of image analysis and deep learning to discover features of the tissue microenvironment that are predictive of patient outcome in prostate and colorectal cancers. Concurrently, he is also interested in investigating how these findings can be combined with findings from other modalities to provide a richer view of cancer biology.
