

Prof. Inti Zlobec

Inti Zlobec is Professor of Digital Pathology at the Institute of Tissue Medicine and Pathology, University of Bern. Originally from Montreal, she obtained her PhD in Experimental Pathology from McGill University, before completing a post-doctoral fellowship at the Institute of Pathology, University Hospital Basel. In 2011, Inti Zlobec joined the Institute of Tissue Medicine and Pathology in Bern, where she established the Translational Research Unit, a core facility for tissue "visualisation" methods and image analysis, and later modernized and led the Tissue Biobank Bern until 2022. The aims of her current research group are on the one hand, to build tools for diagnostic clinical use and on the other to gain novel biological insights into colorectal cancers by using the latest spatial (transcriptomic and protein) tissue visualisation techniques and computational methods. Inti is Chair of the European Society of Pathology Working Group for Digital & Computational Pathology and Co-Founder and President of the Swiss Digital Pathology Consortium.
