Eufrânio N. da Silva Júnior received his degree in chemistry from the Catholic University of Brasília (UCB). In 2010, he became Professor of Organic Chemistry at the Federal University of Minas Gerais (UFMG). He is a member of the Brazilian Chemical Society and the Royal Society of Chemistry. He has received the RSC/BMOS Young Investigator Award (2015), Jones Travelling Fellowship (2016) and Capes/Humboldt Research Fellowship for experienced researchers (2018). His research interests are focused on click chemistry, C-H activation reactions, asymmetric organocatalysis, mechanistic investigations, and the synthesis of heterocyclic and naphthoquinoidal bioactive compounds. Currently, he is also interested in obtaining fluorescent substances for the study of their pharmacological and DNA-binding properties. He has authored 80 scientific publications.
