"New approaches for the synthesis of spirocycles and macrocycles"

In the first half of this lecture, Will is going to talk about work in his group to develop new dearomatising spirocyclisation reactions based on alkyne activation with various π -acidic metal catalysts. The second half will be about the group's work to develop new ways to prepare functionalised macrocycles using Successive Ring Expansion (SuRE) methods.

Biography

After a postdoc with Prof Richard Taylor (in York), Will started his independent career in York in 2016 as a Leverhulme Trust early career fellowship. His group are focused the development of new synthetic methods to make useful molecules – especially spirocycles and macrocycles.
