- ❖ 30-35 hours of internship placement per week
- 1 hour dedicated to onboarding activities, check-ins with Pagoda, reflection activities and Cultural Journal writing
- 30 minutes per week Cultural Mentor interaction
- 1-2 hours Mandatory Pagoda Events participation

SUPPORT AND STRUCTURE

SUPPORT FOR OUR PARTICIPANTS

From the moment participants apply, they are in our care. The students will be introduced to a dedicated member of our team who will be their Pagoda Projects single point of contact for the full duration of the programme, from onboarding to reflection and offboarding.

APPLICATION - The placement process will be organic in that participants have flexibility in the company they approach and following successful interview, may then decide if they wish to commit to the programme or not.

ONBOARDING — An interactive and personal session with a member of the team to provide all the details need to successful begin their Pagoda programme

ONGOING – Weekly check ins for internship, cultural journals and mental wellbeing

OFFBOARDING – Skills learned, knowledge attained, competency data

FEEDBACK – A detailed and personalised report will be provided post programme



In order to ascertain whether the participant has completed the programme to an acceptable standard, our team have developed a standardised criteria.

Participants are made aware of the assessment criteria along with the minimum standards of expected engagement. All participants must also agree number of hours (minimum of 30 per week) with their host company, along with their agreed schedule and put this in writing as part of their onboarding and prior to internship commencement.

Participants are expected to pay a returnable deposit to help ensure accountability.

We feel that some of the most important benefits from an international internship relate to the interpersonal connections and cultural fluency developed during the programme.

We didn't want our remote internships to be any different. As a result, we offer every participant the opportunity to engage with an individual in the host company's location, specifically and exclusively to ensure they receive a valuable, rich cultural exchange

STRUCTURE

Interns and Cultural Mentor are matched based on internship location, interests and availability.

Participants must engage with their Cultural Mentors at least once per week via a mutually agreed platform.

Weekly themes and challenges are provided by Pagoda Projects to encourage engagement and keep it lighthearted and fun!

SUPPORT & TRACKING

Our expectations are clearly outlined as are the goals and benefits of the cultural aspects of their programme.

Onus is on the participant to briefly document their learnings in their Cultural Journal, with supporting media where possible, as part of their weekly check-ins.


