

# **MA900 Start-Up Guide**

### **Biosafety Cabinet and Fluids Check**

- 1. Turn the Biosafety Cabinet's main blower ON. Optional: Turn the AMS blower ON.
- 2. Fill up the sheath tank to 10 L (do not overfill).
- 3. Empty the waste tank and check other fluids as needed.

### **Sort Chamber and Air Supply**

- 1. Wipe down/de-static sort chamber surfaces.
- 2. Clean deflection plates and side-stream windows.
- 3. Remove any collection holders from the chamber.
- 4. Power on the air compressor/turn on the in-house air.
- 5. Turn the blue in-line air switch to the ON position.





# **Instrument and Software Startup**


- 1. Power on the MA900 until STANDBY is displayed.
- 2. Power on the PC, log in to Windows.
- 3. Initialize Cell Sorter Software. Optional: Click the Maintenance icon for additional maintenance steps.
- 4. Log in and scan the QR code of the sorting chip.



# **Load Sorting Chip and Autocalibrate**

- Follow the wizard to load the sorting chip.
- 2. Check the sample line and stream as instructed. Best Practice: De-bubble the sheath filter.
- 3. Use 1 mL of fresh, undiluted, well mixed Sony Auto-setup beads.
- 4. Allow autocalibration to complete.




### **QC and Sample Sorting**

Optional: Perform Daily and Performance QC. Optional: Clean the sample line.

- 1. Sort samples into tubes/plates.
- 2. Perform a bleach/DI rinse for the next user.
- 3. Alternatively, follow the Shutdown Wizard.









#### **Shutdown**

- Under the Cytometer tab, follow the Shutdown Wizard to perform a bleach cleaning and shutdown rinse.
- 2. Power off the MA900.

  Best Practice: Empty the waste and clean the sort chamber.
- 3. Turn off the air supply.
