

## How to find us

From M40 junction 15, follow signs for Wellesbourne along the A429. Warwick HRI is on the right after 3 miles, just before the village.

From Stratford-upon-Avon take the B4086 (first on the left after the river Avon) to Wellesbourne. After 5 miles, just before the village, turn left at roundabout onto the A429. Warwick HRI is on the left after 1/2 mile.
