

Randomness in Geometry of Numbers

Abstract: We discuss the problem of counting solutions of Diophantine inequalities. Remarkably, the corresponding counting function exhibits behaviour similar to behaviour of sums of independent random variables. We explore limiting distribution of this counting function using dynamical systems techniques and, in particular, establish the central limit theorem and the law of iterated logarithm in this context.
