This study is evaluating its effectiveness.

3	Development and pilot trial of primary care based collaborative care for people with serious mental illness	Max Birchwood	01/06/2019	28/02/2021	Aim is to assess whether people with stable, long term mental illnesses can be successfully managed within primary care.
3	Personal characteristics, mental health and wellbeing in Bardet-Biedl syndrome	Hayley Crawford	01/01/2018	31/12/2020	Describes the profile of behavioural, cognitive and emotional characteristics of the syndrome and identifying factors associated with mental health difficulties.

3	Developing the clinical anxiety screen for children with severe to profound intellectual disabilities	Hayley Crawford	02/10/2017	31/12/2020	To develop and evaluate a clinical assessment tool that will differentiate the behavioural markers of anxiety and pain in non-verbal or minimally-verbal children. This will be used by clinicians to effectively triage children onto care pathways within health services.
