The team is exploring options to publish from **core work**, but the majority of publications result from **other grant work**.

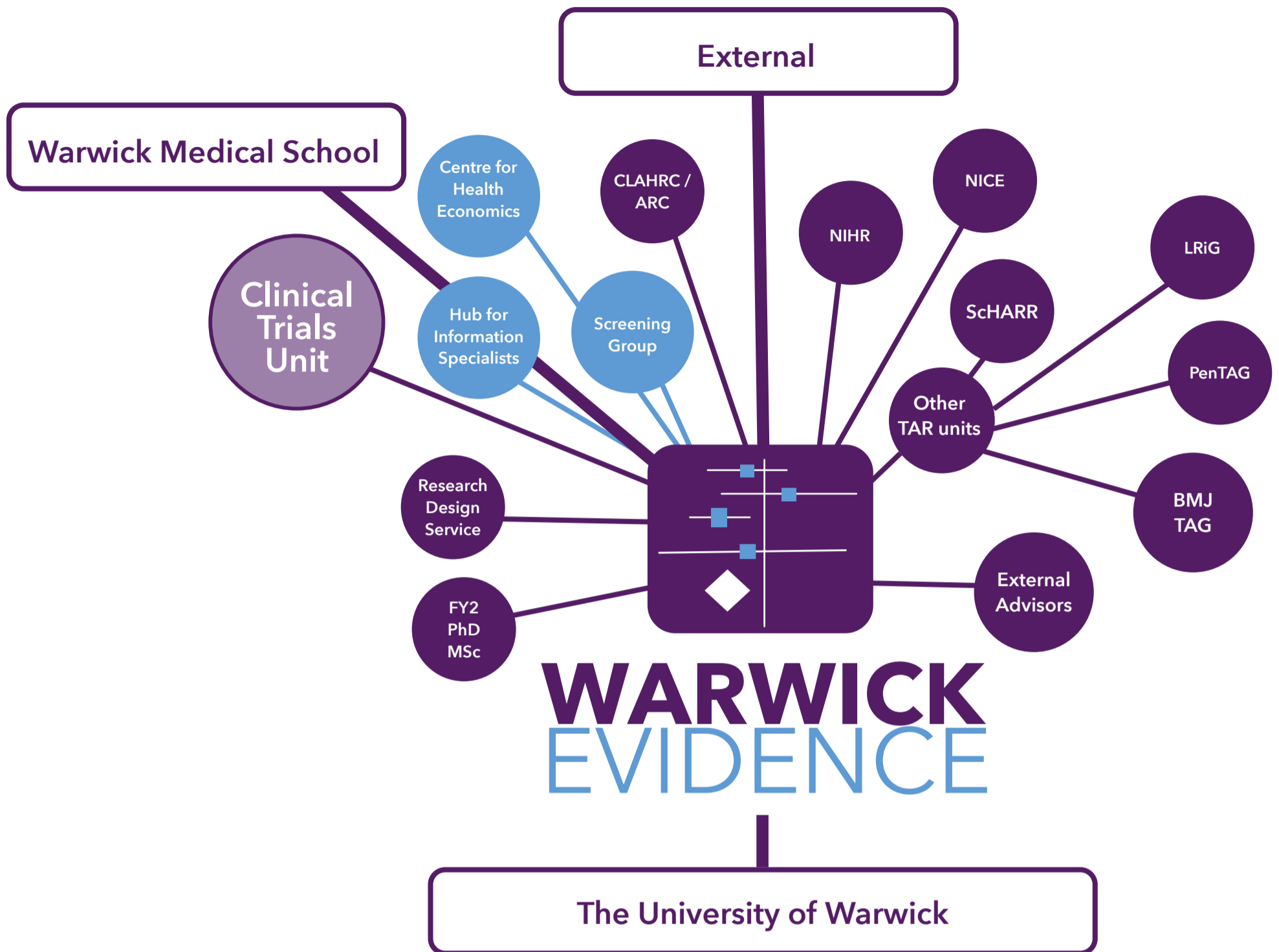
Grant Numbers per Year

Grants with Warwick Evidence staff as PI

In **2019/20** Warwick Evidence staff held **36** grants. Of those, Warwick Evidence members were PI in **16** grants totalling **£18,786,515.03**

The total funding value awarded in grants where there is at least one member of Warwick Evidence Co-I, with an external PI totalled **20** grants totalling **£22,590,876.30**.
