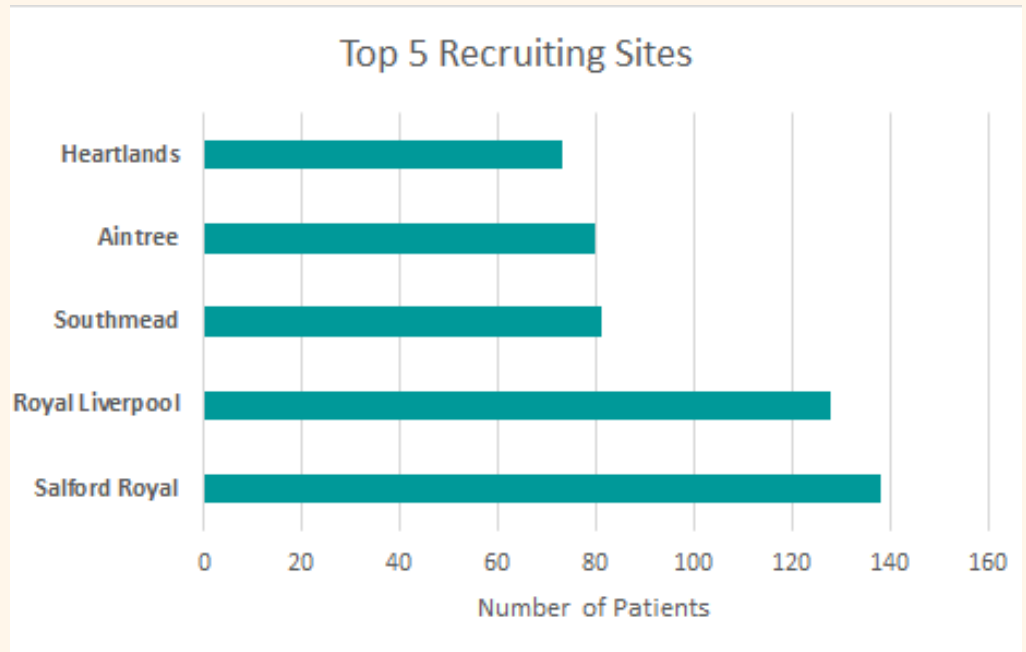

Screening and consent

A large focus of your time is devoted to screening potential patients and seeking informed consent.

As a trial team we hope to assist you as much as we can in this regard since not only is effective screening, consent and recruitment essential to us achieving our trial milestones, it also offers patients and their significant others the opportunity to consider which trials (if any!) are right for them.

We hope our recent screening tool (attached) has helped to re-frame the type of patients who could be considered eligible for the trial. Suspected sepsis is a continuum and includes those who are extremely sick with septic shock but also those who have less severe, although still significant infections.
