

What is AIRWAYS-3?

- A randomised clinical trial comparing two airway interventions during in-hospital cardiac arrest (IHCA): Supraglottic Airway (SGA) vs Tracheal Intubation (TI) - to determine which is more clinically and cost-effective.
- The trial is running in acute hospitals across England and Wales.

Getting started is easy

1) Complete your 10-minute role-specific training. Visit: www.warwick.ac.uk/airways3 or scan the QR code.

2) Sign the delegation log at your trust (not needed if you're only randomising.)

3) Get your PWA/database access: the Warwick team will send this to you.

4) You're ready to go!



Trial Process

A trained AIRWAYS-3 clinician attending a 2222 call will assess patient eligibility and use a PWA (app) to randomise patients to SGA or tracheal intubation.

Boost your portfolio
