Invoices

Baseline Questionnaire

Please remember to ask the patient to give an estimate for every question if they don't do an activity, such as changing a light bulb overhead, as more than 3 blank answers on the DASH scores results in this being invalid.

Operation Note

Remember the form should be completed detailing the experience of the person performing the operation and not the supervisor. Also remember this can be completed by the Research Associate retrospectively in many cases.

Recruitment Update

In January we recruited **26** participants and to date have a total of **349** participants.

We haven't seen the large increase we expected over Winter but we still look likely to recruit above 390 patients.



Centre Progress

All 17 centres are now open and recruiting. We will not be opening any further centres, although we would like to welcome on board the team at **North Tyneside** who work under the same Trust as Wansbeck and begin recruiting this month.
