We have finished recruitment and in total recruited **461** patients which was **18**% over our original target. This is a fantastic achievement and we thank each one of you for you valued contribution in helping make this phase a real success.

Follow up is also going well with **90%** at 3 months, **88%** at 6 months and **91%** at 12 months to date and we have received 68% of patients 12 month x-rays.

During the course of the study there were 38 patients who did not received their allocated treatment following randomisation. There were many reasons for this from being unable to achieve satisfactory reduction in theatre to surgeon preference.
