NSA 23 has been circulated, please be aware that


as of 28th June this amendment will come into

On 26^h June <u>286</u> participants have been randomised and <u>74</u> patients registered awaiting baseline data collection before randomisation. Thank you to all sites for continuing to screen for iRehab, a total of <u>2398</u> people have been screened so far.
