Welcome to the third iRehab trial newsletter. We hope these updates are useful but do let us know if there are any areas you would like us to focus on.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: We have an amendment in place, which some sites have already approved and will come into play 12th April, to contact participants via different contact methods (Whatsapp, text, email, telephone or next of kin). <u>PLEASE CONFIRM WHAT THE PARTICIPANTS PREFERRED METHOD OF CONTACT IS</u>:

1. On the contact details form, next to the telephone number/mobile number or email address select the three dots (*image right*)



- 2. Select Add/view comments
- 3. Enter a comment such as 'Preferred method: email, telephone or text. May not answer phone calls to unknown numbers and is only available via phone in the afternoon' then select 'Post'.



RECRUITMENT: As of 31st March 2023, a total of **36** participants have been randomised and **12** patients registered awaiting baseline data collection before randomisation.

Recruitment to date target: 36/52 (69% of monthly target)

Recruitment total target: 36/428 (8% of overall target)

Well done to **Royal Glamorgan** and **James Paget** for recruiting your first participant this month

Thank you to all sites for continuing to screen for iRehab, a total of 236 people have been screened so far.

TRIAL TIPS

Step One- Screening: Identify patients who are close to being discharged from ICU to the ward. In addition, patients may be identified from clinical lists. In particular, if sites are newly opened, follow-up clinic lists, may be a useful way to identify potentially eligible patients who are within 12 weeks discharge. Please check patients meet the inclusion criteria before entering onto the screening log.

Step Two- Consent: Try and consent the participant and register them within a short period of each other - this allows the participant to receive study documentation as soon as possible and be kept up to date.

Remind the participant there are multiple components to iRehab and they do not need to take part in all of them to be take part in the research.

Step Three- Registration: Ask participants for multiple contact methods including an <u>email address</u>. This enables the research team to contact the participant by phone and email should either prove unsuccessful. PLEASE CONFIRM THE EMAIL ADDRESS AND CONTACT NUMBER(S) ARE CORRECT.

Ad Hoc- Readmission: If you are notified of a readmission, please complete the readmission form on the iRehab database. Date of discharge can be added at a later date when known. This helps the research team when making contact with the participant.

REMINDER NOTICE: We have been in touch with the CRN about how iRehab participants should be recorded on the CPMS, as not all consenting participants will be randomised. They have confirmed to **ONLY** add participants to the CPMS when you receive a **randomisation notification** email confirming trial arm. We will confirm research activity on the 1st of every month for the month of randomisation, not the month of consent. i.e. if you consent someone in June and they are randomised in July the activity will be recorded for July.
