**CPMS NOTICE:** Only add participants to the CPMS/EDGE when you receive a randomisation notification. Entering in the month of randomisation for 'recruited' and 'consented'. We will confirm research activity on 1<sup>st</sup> every month. I.e. if you consent someone in June and they are randomised in July, all activity for this participant should be entered as July. This ensures we are recording the correct accruals at your site.

#### DATABASE UPDATE:

1. The ICNARC number **NO** longer requires three zeroes to be entered in front. Please proceed with entering this information as normal (8 characters)
2. The iRehab Initial and Follow-Up Serious Adverse Event forms (both V2.0 08.02.2023) are now **LIVE** On the database\*, these are no longer required to be completed via paper.

**Consent form, contact details and co-morbidities form must be 100% complete for the participant to be officially registered and questionnaires triggered.**

**RECRUITMENT:** As of 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023, a total of **71** participants have been randomised and **26** patients registered awaiting baseline data collection before randomisation.

Recruitment to date target: 71/91 (78% of monthly target)

Recruitment total target: 71/428 (16.5% of overall target)

Well done to our top recruiter this month: **Royal Liverpool University Hospital**

Well done to **University Hospital Coventry** and **Royal Blackburn Hospital** for recruiting your first participant this month

Thank you to all sites for continuing to screen for iRehab, a total of 504 people have been screened so far.
