## NEW Patient Diaries

### Have you received the NEW Patient Diaries for the trial?

The patient diaries were updated to make it easier for patients and research teams to complete as part of the implementation of Substantial Amendment 04.

The **NEW** Patient Diary (V3.0 08Mar2023) consists of an A5 folder and a series of fortnightly and monthly cards. The Diary Folder is for the patient to store their current Diary Card in between visits while the individual Diary Card details the current dosing regimen and includes a space for the patient to record how much and when they have taken IMP.

The **Patient Diary Site Guide (V1.0)** provides support on how to use the new patient diaries and will be available for download from the electronic Investigator and Pharmacy Site Files soon. The guide is also attached to the newsletter mail out.



**The diaries and ID cards have been posted to sites in September, please let us know if you have not received these.**

## Sharing Prescriptions with REPAIR-MDS

**When sending redacted prescriptions to the Central Trial Team please do so via a secure method by utilising local encryption, password protecting the document (if sending via email) or OneDrive.**

We are in the process of arranging transfer via OneDrive, and/or Microsoft Teams channel. Please contact the Central Team for support if required.

**REMEMBER:** When redacting PDF documents, please ensure that any redaction is **irreversible** by either locking the document when saving or using PDF programme redaction features.

## Understanding Patient Withdrawal

If a patient decides to withdraw from trial there are currently **three levels of withdrawal** the patient can choose between. Below is a quick guide of which trial activities we would expect to cease and carry on.

**The withdrawal process is currently under review and any updates will be communicated to sites directly**
