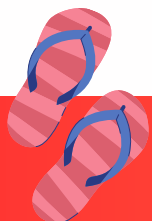

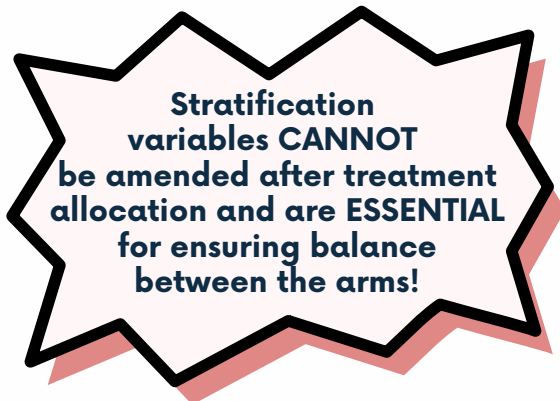

Stratification Variables

Ensure that the stratification variables are correct prior to randomising via the IVRS system:

- **Transfusion Dependence Category**
- **Prognostic Scoring System for MDS (IPSS-R) Score**
- **Participant's Age at Randomisation**

Database Sub-forms

Remember to activate the database sub-forms across the CRF by:

- Activate the sub-form by clicking on the little “+” icon (highlighted in yellow)

- Enter the data in the newly active fields
- Add as many sub-form pages you need by clicking on the “+” again
- Remember to save the form before exiting the CRF!

Pill Counts - Key Reminders

STEP 1

Count how many tablets the patient has brought with them and record in the CRF and medical notes. These are the **tablets remaining.**

STEP 2

Calculate the **tablets taken** by: no. of tablets at last visit (remaining + dispensed) minus no of tablets remaining today. Record in the CRF and medical notes.

STEP 3

Check the tablets taken matches the:

1. Patient Diary entries
2. The number of tablets the patient should have taken based on their prescribed dosing

Record any **missed or extra doses** identified by the pill count or patient diary in the CRF in mg. e.g. 2 x 200mg tablets missed = 400mg missed
